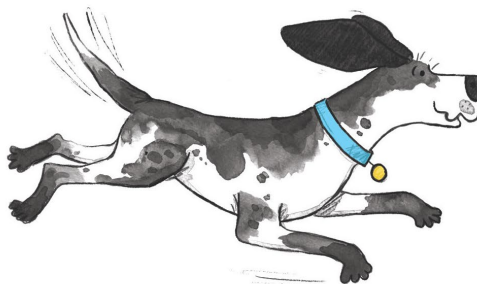
Big Dog shows his emotions through his expressions and his body (especially his tail). How do you think Big Dog is feeling in the pictures below?

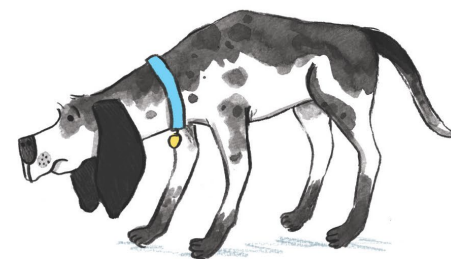
Maybe he's feeling a few emotions at the same time?

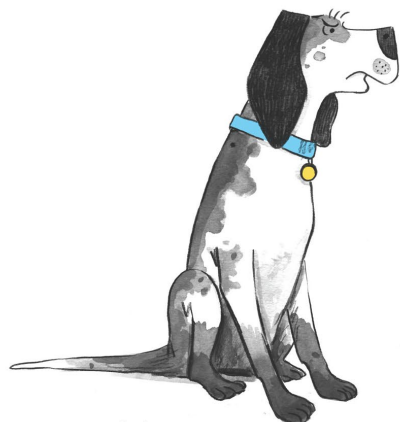
