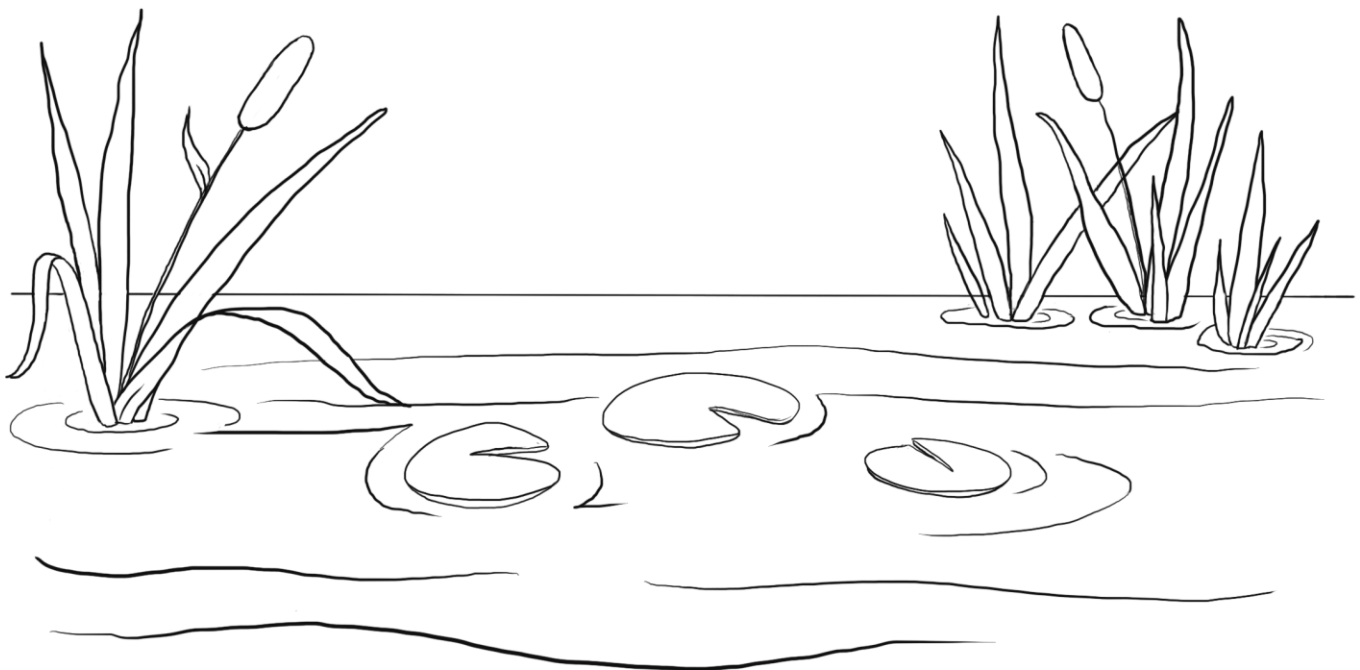
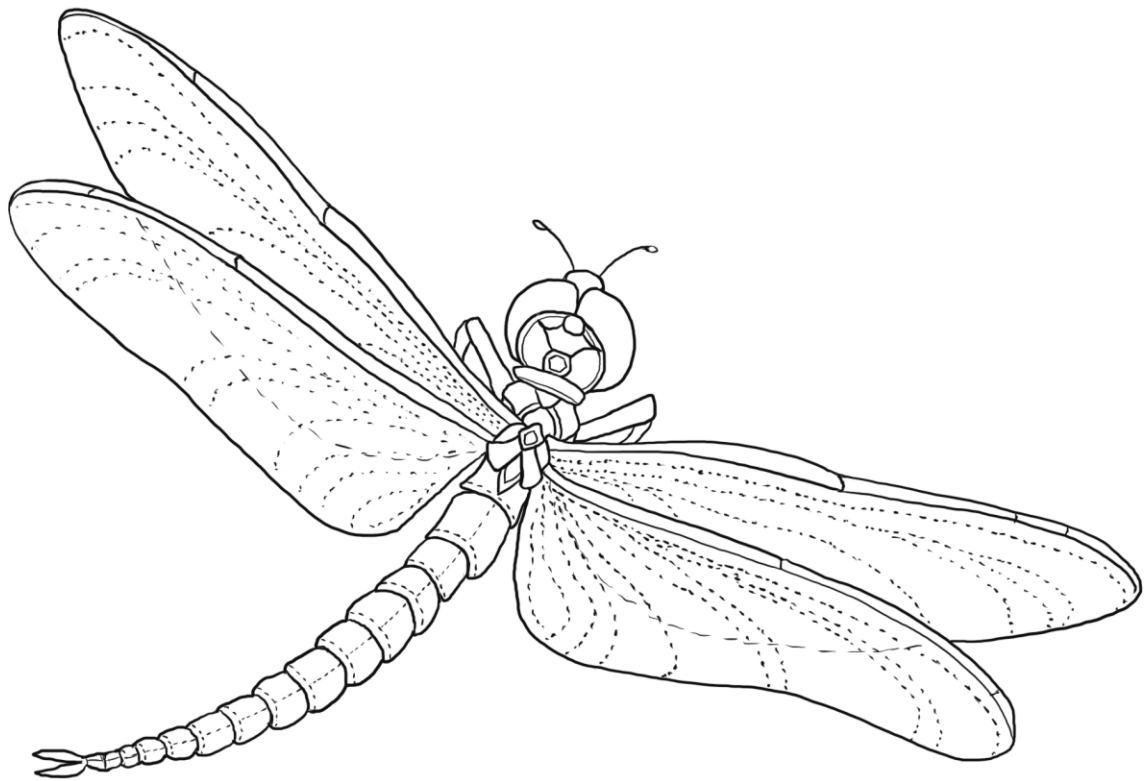




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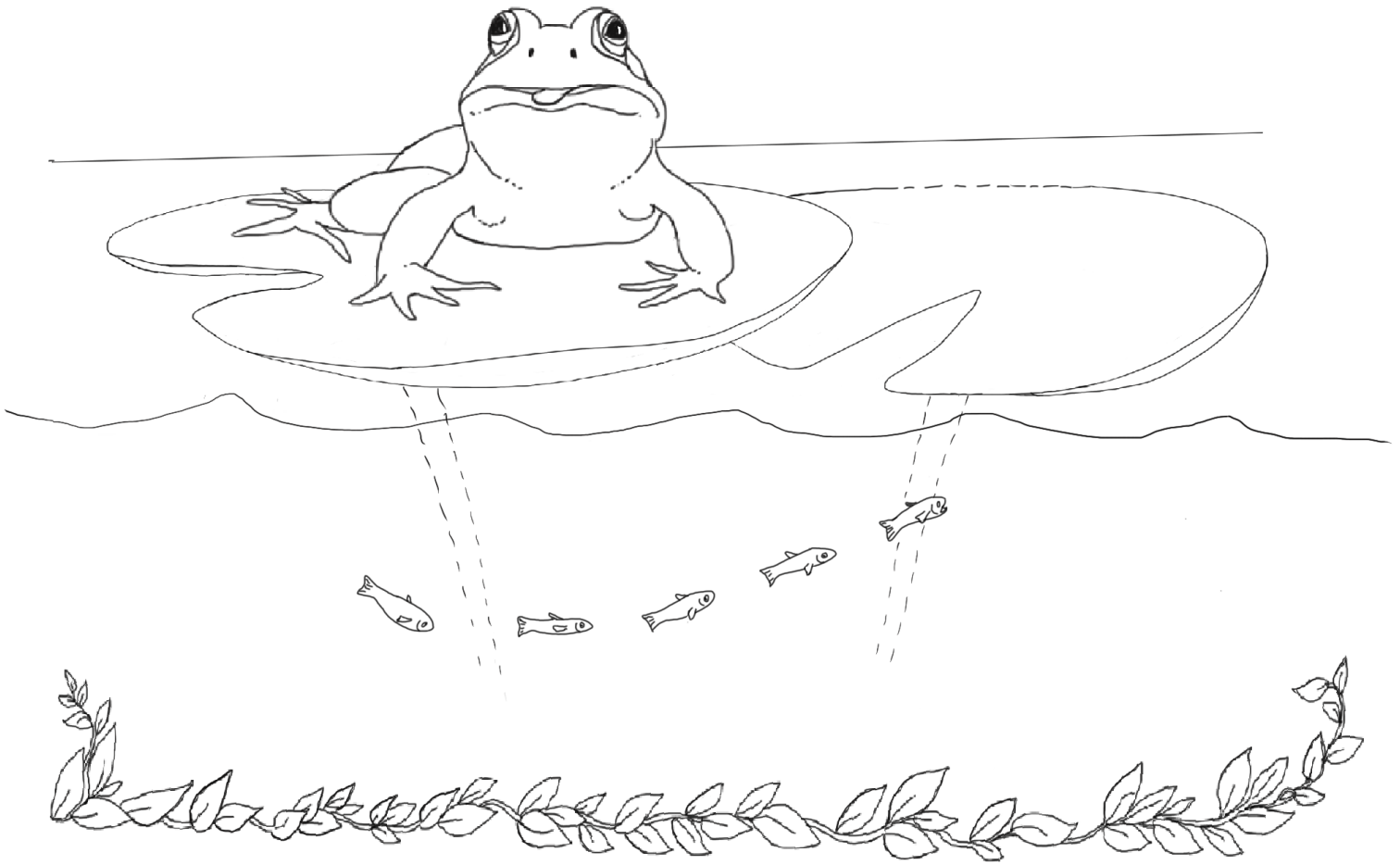
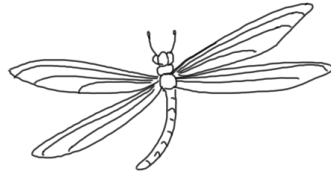




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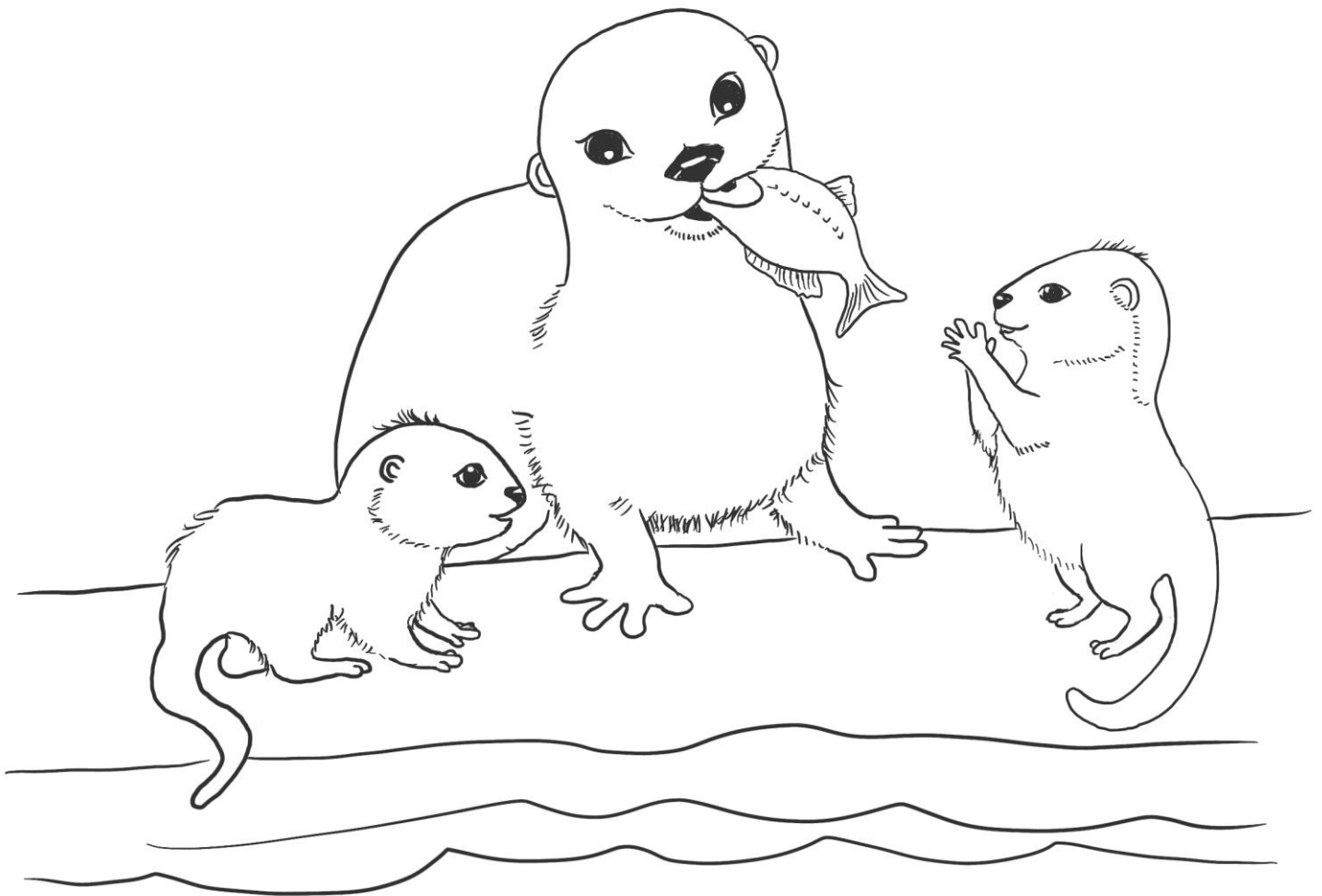




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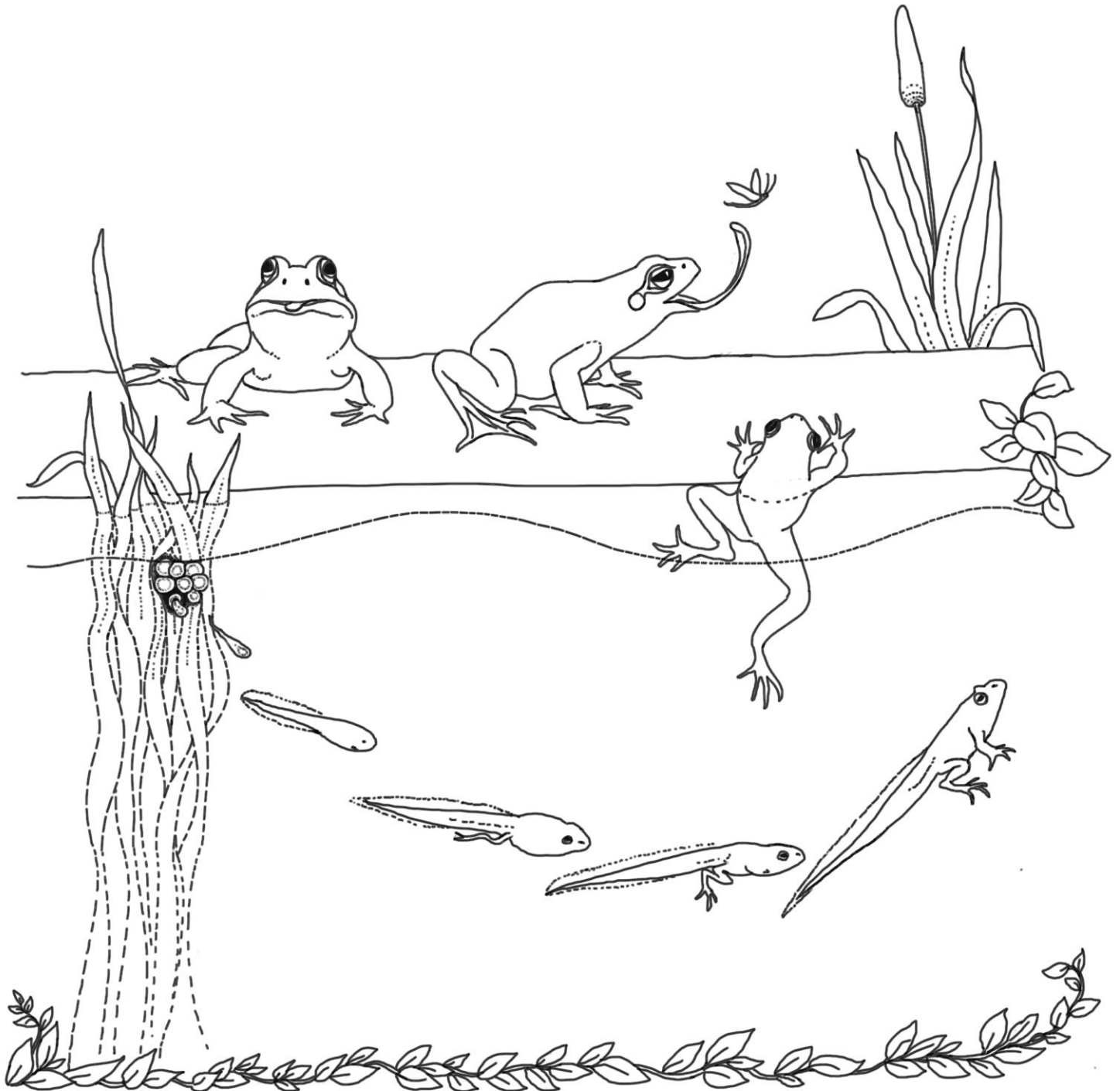




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Instructions

Print the following two pages on heavy paper and cut out the animals. Feel free to color them in. Use for:

- 1) Memory game. Take turns flipping the cards over and try to be the first to match the most pairs.
- 2) Guessing game. Describe one of the animals, for example: "This animal needs to stay wet but sometimes lives on land. It lays eggs in the water. When it first hatches from its egg, it has a tail and gills and no legs." Players then hold up the card of the animal they think is being described.
